Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s),

This semester, your child will have the opportunity to experience a series of lessons and activities which will be created by your child's pre-service teacher from Northern Illinois University. We would like to introduce these activities to you and ask your permission to allow your child/ward to participate in these learning experiences. Your child will be asked to do only the highlighted activity.

The Math activity will be a 20-25 minute interview structured to help your child reflect on a specific mathematics topic taught at the elementary level. The interview questions are meant to see how your child views a math problem with algorithms, real-world situations, and manipulatives.

Your child will be asked what he/she knows about a particular content that is taught in Social Studies at his/her grade level. After completing a lesson on that content with the whole class, your child will again be asked to reflect on what he/she understands about the concept. The pre-teaching interview and post-teaching interview should not last more than 15 minutes each.

The Literacy activities include a content area reading lesson plan and an informal reading test. This informal assessment will help the pre-service teacher to estimate the grade levels at which your child can read independently, and those at which your child will learn the most when given appropriate instruction.

The Science activity will include an assessment about a particular science concept taught at grade level. Your child may be asked to participate in an interview, a paper and pencil task, or a simple science exploration. The process should take no longer than fifteen to twenty minutes.

Participation in these activities is voluntary. Your child's regular classroom teacher will supervise the process. Your child will be asked to indicate agreement prior to participation. Of course, he/she will be free to stop at any time. The activities are non-threatening and should be enjoyable for your child. Your child's participation will also help us prepare better teachers.
