

APPLICATION FOR THE JOSEPH C. AND MARION E. HUBER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR INCOMING TRANSFER STUDENTS

Scholarship Criteria

- a) At the time the award is made, the candidate(s) shall be undergraduate students entering Northern Illinois University as full-time, degree seeking students with a stated interest in majoring in mathematics. Candidate(s) may be entering NIU as either freshmen or transfer students.
- b) Candidate(s) shall come from a rural community or a city of less than or equal to 100,000 in population with a preference given to those with an agriculture background. A letter from the student's parents or legal guardian is required stating the student's connection, if any, to the farming profession.
- c) The candidate(s) shall demonstrate academic merit and accomplishment. Two letters of recommendation are required from former teachers (preferably Math teachers) or employers.
- d) Financial need shall not be a consideration when selecting recipients.
